Most popular startups: _


- **Facebook** initially was intended for pupils and students as a communication platform

- Sky Tronic was honored in 2017 during the European Start-up Days, in the IT related category, Indyustri 4.0. This company is one of the first companies in the world to work on drone control technology using artificial intelligence. The flight control and stabilization algorithms are based on FLC fuzzy logic controller. Thanks to this, it is possible to accurately monitor, evaluate and control the object in the same way as the human brain does. This means that in the future, unmanned aircraft control will be more precise and safe in difficult conditions, be it weather or off-road.
- Vocabla is a notable start up in the group of the best Polish startups. This application is used to learn vocabulary from foreign languages, using specially prepared tests. It helps in the regular learning of foreign languages.
- MailGrupowy is among startups created for young people. This website has been created for students and is intended to exchange information, notes and materials for classes. It has options such as a shared calendar, chat, mobile application and many other amenities. This Polish startup has adopted the Turkish and Indian market, where it is used by students at almost 720 universities. This is a real success.
 - **Explain Everything** is an extremely creative Polish start-up, which is an application for tablets, which is an interactive virtual board for creating animations.
