Role-play: Meeting

1 Work in groups of between five and eleven. One of you plays the role of Barry Jones, chairing the meeting to discuss which of the four approaches – or a combination of these – should be chosen. Each of the other group members plays the role of one of the architects described in the role cards on pages 146-147.

Discuss which role each person will play and prepare carefully for the meeting by reading the role card and thinking about your situation. Barry Jones should read all the other group members' role cards.

2 Now hold a second meeting using the approach(es) selected to decide which architects should be made redundant. For groups of four to six, two should leave; for groups of seven or eight, three should go; and for groups of nine or ten, four should leave.
